

A level Maths:

Proof in Mathematics

Learn how to improve your marks in exam questions involving proof. Proof, Mathematical argument and language is an overarching theme in the A Level Maths specification so is assessed throughout the specification. In this Masterclass we show you how to set out all steps of your argument clearly. We will draw on a variety of examples from several topics in A Level Maths. Wherever you are in your Maths studies, the ability to reason mathematically and present clear arguments are key to success in A Level Maths exam papers.

A level Biology:

1: Getting the most from exams

We will be taking a look at exam technique, common issues that students have with command words, with examples. How to address 6 marker questions and some examples on how they are marked so they can get the most from their answers and the art of getting the most marks from core practical questions.

A masterclass in organic Chemistry

Organic Chemistry is often the area of the specification that students find more challenging. In this session we will break the topic down into more manageable sections. We will ensure we understand the definitions and the requirement for organic analysis as well as explore how to address the questions in the exam. Tips and ideas from an experienced teacher and examiner.

A level Psychology:

Responding to command words in exam questions

Exam questions are designed to assess specific skills: knowledge and understanding (AO1), application and analysis (AO2), and evaluation (AO3). The command words used in questions are chosen to point students in the right direction to show those skills. They also give an indication of how much is expected in an answer. This masterclass will help consolidate awareness of command words and how to use them, and boost confidence in interpreting questions and planning answers.

A level Geography:

Maximising your exam marks

In this Masterclass you will learn how to improve your marks for questions that require an extended piece of writing. These are found all three exam papers, so wherever you are in your geography studies, this masterclass will help you to improve your responses and access the higher levels in the mark scheme.

This can be achieved by Identifying and using the command and key words to 'unpick' the question and produce a concise clearly focused answer; using geographical concepts to structure and develop any discussion or argument; and selecting appropriate evidence from case studies to support your statements.
